This VWR service allows you to check in twice a week and answer questions about your symptoms using regular text and Web check-ins. If you are identified by the VWR as someone with a possible active CDI infection, you will be contacted by this clinical site to schedule an appointment.

Crestone 19-0021 Clinical Trial for CDI

The Crestone 19-0021 clinical trial is studying CRS3123, a novel antibiotic which may stop C. difficile growth and toxin production while preserving the beneficial bacteria present in the gut. If you are 18 years of age or older and have a first or second episode of C. difficile infection (CDI) you may qualify for this study. This study is being done with support from the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID).
